The report also gives details of the medium-term goals that have been set for the period up until 2025," explains Thomas Mosbacher, Managing Director of Finance and Human Resources.

And a special climate formula was developed to illustrate TROX's commitment. "TROX is a highly meaningful company that acts sustainably in two respects – for health and for the environment. This is in line with our tradition, which has always focussed on quality, durability, efficiency, innovation, social-mindedness and a socially responsible approach," says Christine Roßkothen, Head of Corporate Social Responsibility, in concluding the presentation of the sustainability report.
